

COMMENTS ON THE JEWELS

SALVADOR DALÍ, 1959



In the period of the Renaissance, great artists did not restrict themselves to a single medium. Leonardo da Vinci's genius soared far beyond the confines of a picture. His scientific spirit envisaged the possibility of miracles under sea and in the air —now realities. Benvenuto Cellini, Botticelli, da Luca created gems for adornment, goblets, chalices —jeweled ornaments of puissant beauty.

RAISON D'ÊTRE

Paladin of a new Renaissance, I too refuse to be confined. My art encompasses physics, mathematics, architecture, nuclear science —the psycho-nuclear, the mystico-nuclear —and jewelry— not paint alone.

My jewels are a protest against emphasis upon the cost of the materials of jewelry. My object is to show the jeweler's art in true perspective —where the design and craftsmanship are to be valued above the material worth of the gems, as in Renaissance times.

1949

18 karat yellow gold.
On the pin, 13/14 karat yellow gold.
Diamonds (13), diamond cut (round) and 8/8, of 1.5 to 3 mm in diameter approximately.
Natural rubies (corundum), mixed cut (round and oval) of 2 to 4.5 mm approximately.




RUBY LIPS

1949

18 karat yellow gold. Natural rubies (corundum), mixed cut (round and oval), of 2 to 4 mm, approximately. Pearls (13), of 4 to 6 mm in diameter, approximately.

THE EYE OF TIME

1949

Platinum.

Natural ruby (corundum) (1), irregularly-shaped rounded off fragments, polished.

Diamonds, baguette cut (rectangular), diamond cut (round) and 8/8, of 0.5 to 3.5 mm in diameter, approximately.

Enamel (on the dial).

Clock with Movado 50SP mechanism.

THE ROYAL HEART

1953

18 karat yellow gold.

Natural rubies (corundum), mixed cut

(round and oval), of 3 to 5 mm, approximately.

Small stones on the Crown:

Natural rubies (corundum) (8)

Natural sapphires (corundum) (4)

Natural emeralds (beryl) (4)

Aquamarines (beryl) (4)

Peridots (2)

Hessonite garnets (2)

Amethyst (quartz) (1)

Diamonds

Pearls

With moving mechanism and reducer which
